

Madison Office, Residential, & Retail Complex

Madison, CT



This undertaking involved the new construction of a combination of office, retail and apartment spaces in downtown Madison for a local private developer. The project was a multiple story building that accommodated retail space on the first floor, office space on the second and apartments on the third floor.

Construction consisted of wood frame with wood siding, exterior insulation finish systems and brick veneer. Banton performed a large percentage of the trade work from sitework, concrete, rough and finish carpentry, to wood cornice and finishes.

The structure was built in extremely tight logistics with heavy pedestrian and vehicular traffic ongoing daily, as well as active surrounding businesses such as restaurants, shops and a movie theater. The design intent was to blend with the existing residential colonial style of downtown Madison.
