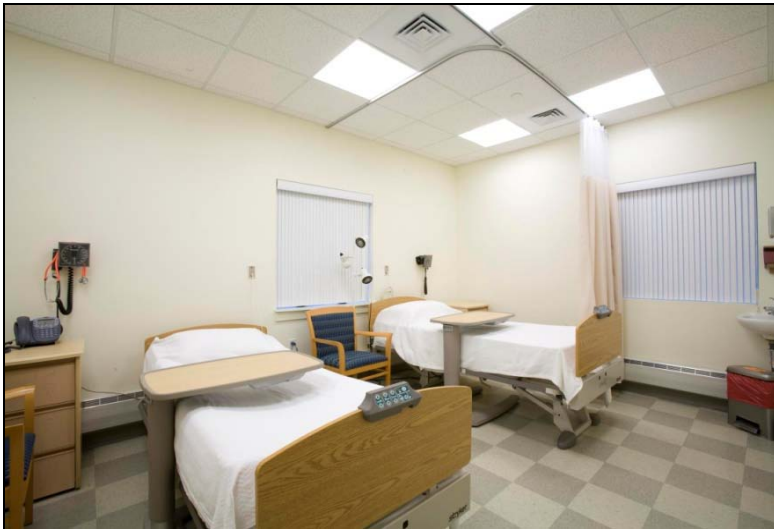
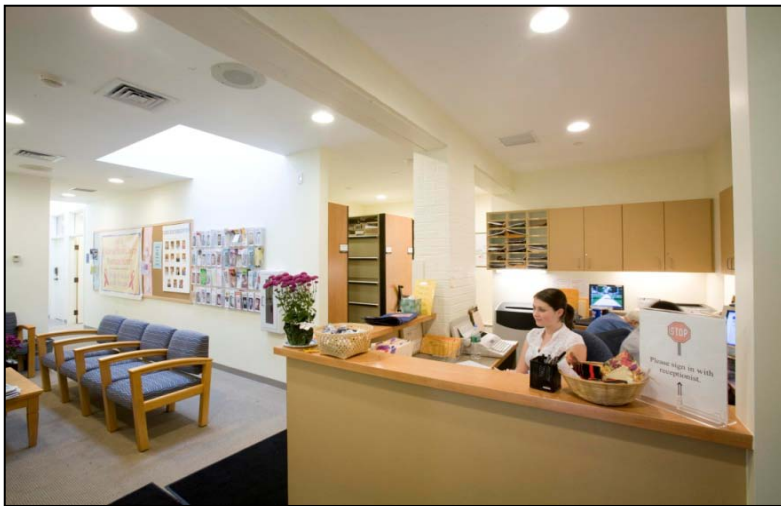


Quinnipiac University

This fast-track project consisted of the complete interior renovation of Quinnipiac University's new infirmary building.

The existing building is the oldest on campus, and was converted from its former function as the university's security offices. The goals of the conversion were to meet the health and wellness needs of the quickly growing student population on Quinnipiac's main campus.

The project included the construction of new examination rooms, as well as staff offices, a conference room, bathrooms and reception, waiting and filing vault areas.

The project was successfully completed on schedule, despite many challenges and unexpected conditions that arose during construction.

This was the first project in Quinnipiac's history to pass the State of Connecticut's Certificate of Occupancy requirements on the first inspection walk through.
