This project involved the complete renovation of the existing high school as well as a 190,000 square foot addition to the building.

Banton served as the electrical trade contractor under the construction manager. Our role in the project involved the implementation of all electrical systems throughout the school. This work included the installation of a stand-by generator system, new state-of-the-art fire alarm, telephone, computer, video, sound and security systems, and a theater complete with lighting and sound systems.

The work was performed in 21 phases and was carefully coordinated to avoid disruption to the school's daily operations.

Banton successfully completed all electrical aspects of the project from the commencement to completion of the project. Toward the conclusion of the project, Banton's work also entailed the testing of all internal systems. This project was completed within budget and on schedule.
