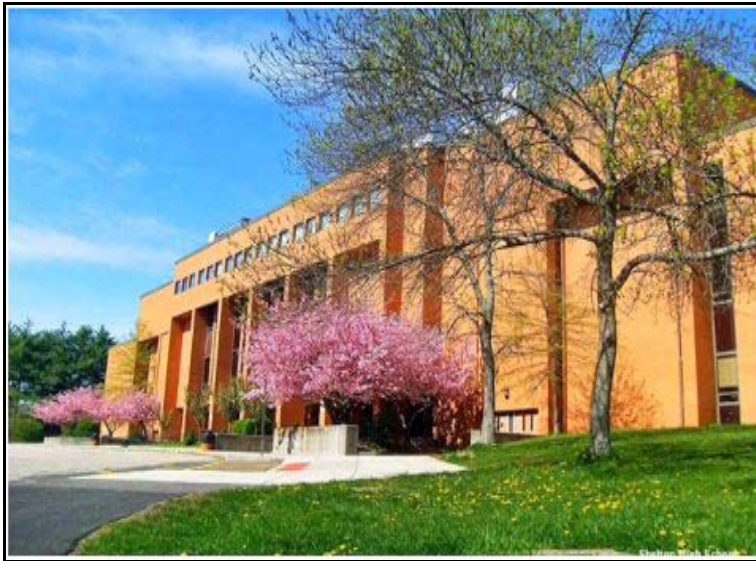


# Shelton High School

## Fire Restoration

Shelton, CT



Banton Construction was retained as an emergency restoration contractor to restore and repair the school, which had been severely damaged by a fire that occurred on December 30, 2008.

The project entailed installing new duct work, floor and ceiling tiles throughout the building, new walls and tiled floors in the media center and refurbishing the gymnasium floor which had partially buckled from water damage.

In the lobby, new terra cotta tiles have replaced the old tiles that cracked straight down the middle from the intense heat of the fire.

The media center, which had to be gutted because of its close proximity to the fire's origin, boasts revamped computer work stations, new walls and skylights.

The school's kitchen has received a new generator, new floor and ceiling tiles and new electrical panels and wiring.

Nearly eight months later, there is no evidence that a fire had occurred and the newly renovated school opened in time for the fall 2009 session.
