

# Sherman School

Sherman, CT



Banton considers Sherman School as one of our keynote projects. The original school was built in 1928 and required extensive structural, environmental and aesthetic improvements.

This project involved the renovation of the existing 30,000 square foot facility including each classroom, administrative offices, and gymnasium.

In addition, new construction of 26,000 square feet added a media center, additional classrooms, a cafeteria and a full service kitchen. Sitework provided a new state of the art playground, extensive site improvements and a new sewage treatment facility.

Construction was performed in phased sequences while the school remained occupied. The original footprint was for 410 students. Current population while under construction was 830 students. Banton orchestrated the student population moves from temporary classrooms, temporary play areas, revised bus drop off and pick up schedules and all the while did not disrupt the primary functions of the school.
