

Sturbridge Commons Office Park

This project involved the complete site development and construction of a nine building office park.

Banton completed the buildings as shells and then returned to complete individual tenant fit-ups as the units were sold. These fit-ups ranged from the offices of attorneys, developers, accountants, architects and insurance companies, and as such, involved the design and construction of many high-end interior fit-ups. A great deal of attention was paid to historic details, particularly trim, cornice and architectural details.

Designed and built to simulate a historic colonial village, this project was completed in record time and serves as one of Banton's first landmark projects. Some seventy percent of the trade work was performed with Banton's in-house tradesmen.
